# Green Mountain Dressage Championship

The Green Mountain Dressage Championship was created by the Green Mountain Horse Association in cooperation with Vermont Dressage Days for the purpose of creating a year end awards program for riders competing in Vermont's USEF/USDF recognized dressage shows.

The goal of this program is to promote dressage competition at all levels, reward consistent excellence by our horses and riders, and provide our riders with a season-long goal attainable within the local area.

The following competitions are part of the 2011 Green Mountain Dressage Championship:

- GMHA June Dressage Show: June 17-19
- GMHA Dressage Days: July 22-24
- Vermont Dressage Days: August 13-14
- GMHA Fall Dressage Show: October 1-2

## Specifications and Rules

Declarations:

Competitors must declare horse and rider combination and level of competition, and pay a nominating fee in order to be eligible to compete in the Green Mountain Dressage Championship.

ANY horse and rider combination is eligible. Horse and rider combination are only eligible at one level per season. Riders may declare multiple horses- separate form and nominating fee for each horse/rider combination are required.

Nominating fees will be as follows: \$20 per horse and rider combination prior to June 17. \$40 per horse and rider combination prior to July 22 (scores from June Dressage Show will count). No declarations will be accepted past July 22. All nominating fees will be paid to the Green Mountain Horse Association, the administrator of this program.

Once declarations are filed, the rider is under no obligation to submit scores or tests- no membership numbers or cards to keep track of!

### Scoring:

The high score at the declared level from each competition will count towards the Green Mountain Dressage Championship.

The highest three out of four scores will be averaged to determine the results of the Green Mountain Dressage Championship. Riders are encouraged to participate in all four shows- in which case the lowest of the four scores will be dropped. Vermont Dressage Days to count as one show.

Ties will be broken by addition of drop scores. A rider with a drop score will win the tie vs. a rider without a drop score. In the event of a tie where neither rider has a drop score, the tie will be decided by the flip of a coin.

Scores from any test at the declared level will count towards the GMDC. If the rider competes in multiple tests at the same level at a show, only the highest score will count.

### Awards:

Ribbons 1-6 will be awarded at Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth, and FEI levels. Awards will be presented for top placings. Awards presentation TBA.

Levels will be split by division (Open, Adult Amateur, Junior) ONLY if entries warrant.
